

MEX PACK (SC V2.00)

Welcome!

Mex Pack (SC V2.00) contains some programs specially developed by **Enzo Messina** (professional pianist / keyboard player - www.mexkeys.com - youtube.com/@MeXKeys) with the new sound library V2.00 for the Sound Collection module of the Legend '70s Stage Piano. The video with the demo of all the sounds present in this pack can be found [Here](#).

This requires updating the firmware release of the instrument to V1.10 and the Sound Collection module to V2.00 (refer to par. "Release/Update function" and "Updating the instrument's modules" of the User Manual).

All programs included in the pack can be loaded into the instrument using the "Legend '70s Editor" application, available for Windows, MacOS and iOS. Programs can also be loaded directly from the instrument with a USB flash drive.

"Legend '70s Editor" is completely free and can be downloaded from the website www.viscountinstruments.com.

How to load program with the "Legend '70s Editor"

- 1 – Download and install the "Legend '70s Editor" to your computer (www.viscountinstruments.com).
- 2 – Connect USB cable to the instrument and press [CONNECT] button on the application.
- 3 – Click the [PROGRAM] button on the top menu of the application and select the program location you want to replace from the program list.
- 4 – Click [LOAD] button to load the program file .L7P in the current location.

How to load program files with a USB flash drive

- 1 – From your computer, copy all the program files .L7P into the <Legend'70s\Program> folder of the USB flash drive.
- 2 – Insert the USB flash drive in the USB [TO DEVICE] connector of the instrument.
- 3 – From the instrument, select the program you want to replace. Enter UTILITY page under the SYSTEM menu and move to the Load functions. Select "Load Program" function and press the data entry dial.
- 4 – Scroll through the program files on the USB flash drive with the dial data entry and select the program you want to load. Press enter to confirm.
